**Read Luke 6:1-19**

Throughout his book, Luke tells us who Jesus is. Especially is this true in the first five and half chapters, but it continues until the Ascension at the very end of the book. In Luke's narrative, Jesus did many things, but if we begin to allow the Spirit to weave the stories together, we see a different narrative, a narrative that is telling us just who this Jesus is.

Let's take a look at part of that narrative: from his baptism to until his first major teaching session.

15. Disciple/Regular Guy (5:27-32)
16. Bridegroom (5:33-39)
